

Captain Matthew Easton CMMar

Matt has been a Liverpool Pilot since 2002, the last 10 years as a senior pilot. In addition to pilotage duties he is currently the Liverpool Pilot's Designated Person for the International Standards of Pilotage Organisations (ISPO) safety management system and has represented Liverpool Pilots at the last 5 ISPO conferences.

In 2017, he was the first in the world to be granted Chartered Master Mariner status, in recognition of his contribution to the industry.

Since 2007 Matt, along with 2 of his colleagues, has been developing, delivering and presenting bridge resource management / human factors courses, mainly to Pilots. Courses have been delivered in Liverpool, the Tees, Falmouth, Gravesend and Hamburg. He has presented on the subject at 2 UKMPA conferences.

Matt is also a Younger Brother of Trinity House London and a Liveryman of the Honourable Company of Master Mariners.
